Jeong Da-Hye (b. 1989 in Jeju, Korea) received her B.F.A. in Sculpture from Jeju National University and her M.F.A. in Traditional Arts and Crafts (Traditional Clothing & Textile) from Korea National University of Cultural Heritage. Inspired by the traditional Korean men's headwear 'gat' (갓) worn during the Joseon Dynasty, Jeong mastered the ancient technique of horsehair weaving and innovatively experimented with different shapes and patterns. She skillfully transforms loose horsehair into intricate three-dimensional forms, including vessels, sculptural objects, and relief wall pieces. Jeong's talent has garnered significant global attention and recognition, including the Grand Prize at the Cheongju International Craft Competition in 2021 and the LOEWE FOUNDATION Craft Prize in 2022. Her works are included in the collections of renowned organizations such as the British Museum and Musée du quai Branly.

Jeong Da-Hye 1989年生於韓國濟州，先後畢業於濟州大學雕塑系學士及韓國傳統文化大學傳統藝術工藝(傳統服飾及紡織品)碩士。精研韓國朝鮮時代男帽「笠」(갓)的製作工藝，以極其精湛的傳統馬毛編織技術，巧妙地將幼細柔軟的馬鬃反覆以幾何圖案進行錯綜複雜的編織，轉化為各種容器、裝置藝術、浮雕裝飾等結構堅固的立體三維形態。Jeong Da-Hye重新定義了當代工藝的無限可能性，創新詮釋馬毛編織這項擁有超過500年歷史的傳統技藝，因此獲得國際廣泛關注及肯定，包括榮獲2021年清州國際工藝競賽大獎及2022年LOEWE基金會工藝獎，其作品更被大英博物館及法國凱布朗利博物館等多個國際機構納入永久館藏。
