Soluna Fine Art is proud to present the first solo exhibition of Korean contemporary artist Oh Se-Yeol with the gallery. Known as a 'master painter' in Korea, Oh has embarked on a creative journey for over five decades. The exhibition will show-case Oh's latest works completed between 2020 and 2024, along with selected oeuvres from the past. Inheriting the essence of Korean monochrome movement, Oh challenges the conventional notions of paintings by incorporating scribbles, objects and collages into his works. Covering the monochromatic background with repetitive numbers, sometimes interrupted by the presence of everyday objects, Oh's works resemble a childhood diary or chalkboard doodles. He uses simple pictorial language, in which each symbol is open to interpretation, inviting the audiences to reconnect with their own memory and reclaim the lost innocence of their inner child.

Oh Se-Yeol's works will also be featured in the ninth edition of Art Central from 28 to 31 March 2024.

About Oh Se-Yeol

Oh Se-Yeol (b. 1945 in Seoul, Korea) obtained B.F.A in painting from Seorabeol University of Arts and received his M.F.A from Chung-Ang University Graduate School of Arts in Seoul. By using numerous materials such as oil paint, acrylic paint, conté, gouache in his works, Oh's unique creations aren't confined to any type of art. He often incorporates youthful elements such as scribbles of numerical digits and collages of everyday objects into his paintings, expressing childlike innocence and purity. Despite living through the Korean War and witnessing the country's rapid social development, Oh's works focus on personal memory rather than collective ones, inspiring audiences to interpret his works through their own imaginations and emotions.

Since the 1970s, Oh has exhibited extensively both domestically and internationally, including Hakgojae Gallery in Korea, Galerie Vazieux in France, Pontone Gallery in UK, Korean Cultural Center in Belgium, and more. His works are acquired by numerous museums and private collections, including National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art, Korea, Leeum Samsung Museum of Art, Frederick R. Weisman Art Foundation. Soluna Fine Art誠意呈獻韓國當代藝術家吳世烈與畫廊的首次同名個展。作為在 韓國享負盛名的大師級畫家,吳世烈在藝術創作領域持續深耕超過五個世紀。 是次展覽將展出吳世烈於2020年至2024年間完成的全新作品,並回顧藝術家 的部分早期創作。承襲韓國單色畫運動精神的同時,吳世烈為其繪畫作品加入 塗鴉、圖像、拼貼等元素,打破傳統繪畫的既定形式。吳世烈的作品容易讓人 聯想起兒時的日記或黑板上隨心繪畫的亂筆,他在單色背景上反覆塗寫數字, 並偶爾穿插日常生活中常見的物件。吳世烈透過簡單直接的圖像語言,利用可 被自由解讀的符號,邀請觀眾喚起屬於自己的記憶,重拾內在童心的單純與美 好。

吴世烈的作品同時亦會於2024年3月28日至31日在第九屆Art Central中展出。

關於吳世烈


吴世烈1945年生於韓國首爾,畢業於韓國徐羅伐藝 術大學繪畫系,並從韓國中央大學取得藝術碩士學 位。吳氏的作品運用多種材料如油彩、丙烯顏料、 炭筆、水粉,不拘泥於任何藝術形式的限制。他經 常將數字塗鴉及日常用品拼貼等充滿童心的元素融 入繪畫當中,表達出原始童稚的天真純粹。儘管經 歷過韓戰並見證社會的急遽變遷,吳世烈的作品著 重於個人記憶而非集體敘事,啟發觀眾透過自己的 想像和情感來詮釋他的作品。

自七十年代起,吳氏於韓國及海外均有展出,包括 韓國學古齋畫廊、法國Vazieux畫廊、英國Pontone 畫廊、駐比利時韓國文化院等。他的作品亦被韓國 國立現代美術館、韓國Leeum三星美術館、美國魏 斯曼美術館等多個著名美術館及私人團體收藏。








